Project

Design & install a 29kW PV system including roof mounting, PV modules, DC cabling, Inverters, AC cabling, Batteries, 2 x EV chargers, Network Grid connection, testing and commissioning. System to be compatible and integrated with existing 11Kw PV system and batteries.

Specifications

PV modules to be split over East/West roofs – 29kW

Battery system – 15kW

EV charging x 2 – 11kW

Notifications to Distribution Network Operator (National Grid)

Installation to be completed in accordance with BS 7671 & compliance to enable SEG payments

Certification of the PV system under the MCS scheme

Testing and Certification of all electrical works

Provision of manufacturer's warranties and 10-year workmanship warranty on installation work.

Score	Rating	Description
0	Poor	No response and/or evidence is unacceptable or non-existent, or there is a failure to properly address any issue. The purchasing organisation does not have any confidence in the bidder's experience, capacity and ability to meet its requirements.
1	Weak	The response and/or the evidence are deficient (or not relevant) in the majority of areas and the purchasing organisation has a low level of confidence in the bidder's experience, capacity and capability to meet its requirements.
